INTRODUCTION

The first issue of the G.B. JOURNAL was dated December 1956. Volume One was completed by the tenth number issued two years later and the pattern of ten issues to a volume continued up to the end of Volume Six, November 1968. The opportunity was then taken to change to a pattern of six issues per year and one year per volume. Thus Volumes Seven to Ten coincided with the calendar year (1969 to 1972).

The purpose of this publication is to provide a comprehensive index to all the material in the first ten volumes of the G.B. JOURNAL that is likely to be of interest to the society member, both present and future. The normal practice has been followed of providing both an author index and a subject index with entries duplicated under different headings where it is felt to be justified. It is hoped that the index will be of value not only to those possessing a complete set of these Journals but to all members of the society.

Some degree of selection has been made but hopefully not departing appreciably from the terms of reference. All book reviews and most items of correspondence, and notes, have been indexed. Where short contributions, notes, and letters appeared without headings, these have been given a short descriptive title to provide entries for the index.

The first few volumes included not only original articles, book reviews and correspondence but also material concerned with the day to day running of the society, such as lists of new members, mention of meetings and the like. This was soon felt to be incompatible with the purpose of a journal such as the GBJ, and these were transferred to a monthly publication "*The G.B.P.S. Newsletter*" which practice has continued to the present.

To find an entry in the index if one knows the author but is not sure of the title, then consult the Author Index. If instead you remember the broad subject of the article, or are interested to see what information is available, then consult the Subject Index, going through one of the major headings. With a specialised subject this approach is more useful to the user of an Index than the straight alphabetic where so much depends on key words. Within most headings the arrangement is chronological.

All book reviews are listed in a third section and are arranged alphabetically according to the author of the book. The publisher is shown if the book is a "company publication" as are many catalogues.

To find the particular issue in which a reference will be found, consult the Pagination Table overleaf.

The continuing issues of the Journal are being indexed on the same lines. Therefore it will be possible to publish an index to Volumes 11 to 20 when the time comes or to publish a combined index to Volumes 1 to 20. In the meantime, notification of any errors in this book that come to light will be welcomed and should be reported to the Editor of the Journal who will see that they are recorded.
