Service 2. London-Brussels-Cologne.

The Brussels (letter) Air Mail now closes in London (G.P.O.) at 6.0 am. instead of 11.0 am.

The second Cologne (letter) Air Mail formerly closed in London (G.P.O.) at 11.0 a.m. has been discontinued.

Service 3. London-Amsterdam.

The second (letter) Air Mails for Rotterdam and Amsterdam formerly closed in London (G.P.O.) at 11.0 a.m. have been discontinued.

New Letter Air Mails to Germany (London-Hamburg-Berlin).

Special fee 3d. per ounce, or part of an ounce, in addition to ordinary foreign postage. Parcels cannot at present be sent.
