INSURED LETTERS AND BOXES BY AIR MAIL

Insured letters and boxes may be sent by air to those countries outside Europe against which an indication appears in column 6 on pages 2-4. They are subject to the general regulations for insured letters and boxes set out at pages 112-115 of the Post Office Guide and the maximum amounts of insured value are the same as those applicable to the surface route. The normal insurance fees are payable in addition to the letter air postage rate in the case of insured letters, and in addition to the second class air postage rate in the case of insured boxes. Insured boxes sent by air are subject to the same minimum charge as insured boxes sent by surface route, viz., 1s. 3d. plus the insurance fee.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FOREWORD

This leaflet is issued monthly and contains information effective on the first of the month. It will be supplied regularly by post if a standing order is placed with the local Head Postmaster. The air mail services are subject to alteration from time to time, and particulars of any important changes which occur between successive issues of the leaflet may be obtained on inquiry at a post office.

EUROPEAN ALL-UP SERVICE

All letters (including letter packets) and postcards for European countries (except Iceland and Poland) are sent by air as the normal means of transmission whenever this will result in earlier delivery (see page 5). The general regulations regarding surface mails are applicable. Air mail labels should not be used.

SURCHARGE AIR MAIL SERVICES

Letters and Postcards: The regulations applicable to ordinary surface mails published in the Post Office Guide apply also to surcharge air mails. Where restrictions as regards limit of weight and registration facilities are in force, particulars are shown against the countries concerned on pages 2-5.

Air Mail Label: A blue air mail label, obtainable free of charge at any post office, must be affixed to each air mail item at the top left hand corner on the address side; alternatively, the indication By Air Mail may be written boldly in the same position; but the absence of an air mail label may lead to delay.

Air Letters: Air Letters, postage 6d., written on special Air Letter forms, may be sent to all countries outside Europe to which there are surcharge air mail services (see pages 2-4). These special forms may be obtained at post offices, but privately manufactured forms may be used providing they bear an indication that they have been approved by the Postmaster General. Enclosures are not permitted.

SECOND CLASS MAIL BY AIR

Printed Papers, Commercial Papers, Samples, Small Packets (to those countries which admit them) and Literature for the Blind may be sent as second class mail by air to the whole of the British Commonwealth and most foreign countries outside Europe at the reduced rates of postage shown in column 4 on pages 2-4. Such items must conform to the general regulations for second class mail set out on pages 81 to 91 of the Post Office Guide, should be labelled for air mail as above, and should be clearly superscribed in the upper left hand corner of the cover for the particular service intended, namely, Printed Papers, Commercial Papers, Sample, "Blind" Literature

or Small Packet, as the case may be. They must not contain anything in the nature of a current letter nor be sealed against inspection. The minimum charges of 7-d. applicable to Small Packets and 4d. to Commercial Papers sent by surface route (see pages 81 and 86 of the Post Office Guide) apply also to Small Packets and Commercial Papers sent by air mail.

AIR PARCELS

Parcels may be sent by air at the postage rates indicated regards maximum weight and dimensions, customs declarations, despatch notes, compensation, and so on, apply to air parcels. Apart from insurance, the same supplemental services as for surface parcels are supplemental services as for surface parcels, as regards maximum weight and dimensions, customs declarations, despatch notes, compensation, and so on, apply to air parcels. Apart from insurance, the same supplemental services as for surface parcels are available. supplemental services as for surface parcels are available to countries outside Europe. (For details, see Post Office Guide.) The supplemental services to European countries are shown in column 4 on page 6. Insured parcels are not accepted. A blue air mail label must be affixed close to the address (or to each address if the parcel is addressed in more than one place), to the relative despatch note if one is used and to the trade charge card for C.O.D. parcels. In addition to the acceleration afforded by air conveyance, air parcels are usually given speedy customs clearance abroad.

POSTING TIMES

The latest times of posting shown in this leaflet are those applicable to unregistered correspondence posted at the London Chief Office, King Edward St., E.C.1, and are closely related to the despatch of the mails. The latest posting times elsewhere, which in general are earlier than the London Chief Office times, can be executed as the control of the contro ascertained by inquiry at the local Head or Branch post office. At certain post offices in Scotland, the latest times of posting for some destinations may be later than at the London Chief Office because Scottish air mails for these destinations are despatched by air from Prestwick. See also the notice "Christmas Mails for Abroad, 1951" exhibited in post offices.

TIMES OF TRANSMISSION

A guide to the times of transmission of air mails from London to the principal cities of countries outside Europe is given in column 8 on pages 2-4. The times shown do not allow for intervals between arrival and delivery in the country of destination. No guarantee can be given that the times shown will invariably be achieved.

SERVICES TO H.M. FORCES

Special air mail rates apply to correspondence for all members of H.M. Forces overseas. Particulars may be obtained on inquiry at any post office.
