THE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (No. 1) WARRANT, 1904. DATED DECEMBER 7, 1904.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:-

- 1. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Inland Post Warrant to be Warrant, 1903,* (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal read as one Warrant") and all Warrants amending the same.
- 2. Clause 11 of the Principal Warrant is hereby repealed, and the following clause shall be substituted in lieu thereof, namely:
 - 11.—(1) Postage may be prepaid either—
 - (a) by adhesive postage stamps; or
 - (b) by the use of a stamped envelope, cover, postcard, or other postal form; or
 - (c) by the use of an embossed or impressed stamp cut out of or otherwise detached from an envelope, cover, postcard, or other postal form; or
 - (d) in the case of letters, postcards, halfpenny packets, and parcels, in money.

Repeal of Clause 11 of Principal Warrant and substitution of new clause.

Mode of payment.

Provided that—

- (i) no stamp indicating on the face thereof payment of a registration fee as well as postage shall be used in payment of postage on any unregistered postal packet, and
- (ii) payment of postage in money shall be made only at such Post Offices, within such hours, and under and subject to such regulations, conditions, and restrictions as the Postmaster-General shall from time to time prescribe.
- (2) A "Postal form" means a form issued by or under the authority of the Postmaster-General.

Printing of Principal Warrant, 3. From and after the date of this Warrant the Principal Warrant shall be printed from time to time as amended by all Warrants made prior to the date of such printing.

Short title.

4. This Warrant may be cited as the "Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Warrant, 1904."

Commencement of Warrant. 5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the First day of January, 1905.
