We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners order, direct, and declare as follows :-

- 1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 6) Warrant, 1903.
- 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Warrant to be Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1902 * (hereinafter referred to as read with "the Principal Warrant"), and all Warrants amending the same. Warrants.

3. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable under the Rates on Principal Warrant on outgoing parcels addressed to Aden, India, parcels to including places in the Powing Gulf and in Turkish Archic in Aden and including places in the Persian Gulf and in Turkish Arabia in which there are Indian Postal Agencies, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General there Maximum shall not be forwarded, conveyed, or delivered by post under this weight and Warrant any parcel the weight of which shall exceed eleven pounds or the dimensions of which shall exceed three and a half feet in length or six feet in length and girth combined.
