- (2) In proviso (3) to Clause 16 of the Principal Warrant four hundred pounds shall be substituted for one hundred and twenty pounds.
- 3. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 7) Warrant, 1907."
- 4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the First day Commenceof July, 1907.
