**THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT
(No. 9) WARRANT, 1907. DATED JULY 19, 1907.**

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and

under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 9) Warrant, 1907."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906* (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Warrant"), and all Warrants amending the same.

Rates on parcels to New Zealand.

3. In lieu of the rates of postage specified in Part I. of the Second Schedule to the Principal Warrant with respect to outgoing parcels addressed to New Zealand (including Cook and Hervey Islands), the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto shall be substituted.

Commencement of Warrant. Date.

4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 25th day of July, 1907.
