We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order. direct, and declare as follows:—

Short Title.

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 13) Warrant, 1908.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,[†] and all Warrants amending the same.

3. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on outgoing Bates on parcels addressed to the British East Africa Protectorate, there parcels to shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the East Africa Schedule hereto.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General there Maximum shall not be forwarded, conveyed, or delivered by post under weight and dimensions. this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight or dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 14th day of Commence January, 1908.
