THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 24) WARRANT, 1908. DATED OCTOBER 5, 1908.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 24) Warrant, 1908."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906* (hereinafter called "the Principal Warrant"), and all Warrants amending the same.

Repeal.

- 3.—(1) The entries in Part I. of the Second Schedule to the Principal Warrant relating to parcels addressed to Persia and Russia (including Finland) respectively, are hereby repealed.
- (2) The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 10) Warrant, 1907,† is hereby repealed.

Rates on parcels to places specified in Schedule. 4. On every outgoing parcel addressed to any of the places specified in the Schedule thereto there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage mentioned against the names of such places respectively in such Schedule.

Maximum weight and dimensions.

5. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General there shall not be forwarded, conveyed, or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight or dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Commencement of Warrant. 6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 14th day of October, 1908.
