We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

- 1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 30) Warrant, 1909."
- 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Warrant to Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Warrant"), and all Warrants amending the existing warrants.
- 3. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on out-going Rates on parcels addressed to Rhodesia, the rates of postage specified in the parcels to Schedule hereto shall be substituted.
