THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 43) WARRANT, 1911. DATED OCTOBER 21, 1911.

1911. No. 1042.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Act, 1908,* and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the recommendation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 43) Warrant, 1911."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906† (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Warrant"), and all Warrants amending the same.

Rates on parcels to the Nyasaland Protectorate. 3. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on out-going parcels addressed to the Nyasaland Protectorate (in the Principal Warrant referred to as "The British Central Africa Protectorate"), there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.

Maximum dimensions.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the dimensions of which shall exceed the dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Commencement of Warrant.

Date.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 7th day of November, 1911.
