**THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT
(No. 45) WARRANT, 1911. DATED DECEMBER 29, 1911.**

1911. No. 1297.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 45) Warrant, 1911."

Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post ;--British Solomon Islands 339
and Gilbert and Ellice Islands Protectorates.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,* and all Warrants amending the same.

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

3. The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 6) Warrant, 1907,† is hereby repealed.

4. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on outgoing parcels addressed to the British Solomon Islands Protectorate, and transmitted *viâ* New South Wales, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in Part I. of the Schedule hereto.

Rates on parcels to British Solomon Islands Protectorate.

5. On every outgoing parcel addressed to the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Protectorate, and transmitted *viâ* New South Wales, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in Part II. of the Schedule hereto.

Rates on parcels to Gilbert and Ellice Islands Protectorate.

6. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Maximum weight and dimensions.

7. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1912.
