Short title.

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. 1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 53) Warrant, 1912."

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906, + and all Warrants amending the same.

On every outgoing parcel addressed to Peru (any Depart- Rate on ment except Loreto*) and transmitted viâ the Isthmus of Panama certain and on every outgoing parcel addressed to Venezuela and trans- parcels to Peru and mitted by sea direct, there shall be charged and paid the Venezuela. respective rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of Commence-January, 1913.
