THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 54)  
WARRANT, 1913. DATED JANUARY 23, 1913.

1913. No. 67.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Act, 1908,\* and all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the recommendation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the authority of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows :—

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 54) Warrant 1913." Short title.
2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,† and all Warrants amending the same. Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.
3. In lieu of the rates of postage now payable on out-going parcels addressed to French Indo-China and Madagascar, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the schedule hereto. Rates on parcels.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight or dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1913.
