Commencement of Warrant. Date 4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight or dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

February, 1913.
