THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 55)
WARRANT, 1913. DATED MARCH 13, 1913.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise
of all powers given to us by the Post Office Act, 1908,* and of

all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows :—

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 55) Warrant, 1913." Short title.
2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,* and all Warrants amending the same. Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. Repeal.
3. The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 52) Warrant, 1912,† shall, so far as it relates to outgoing parcels addressed to Tripoli (Africa), be deemed to be hereby repealed.
4. On every outgoing parcel addressed to Libia there shall be charged and paid the respective rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto. Rates on parcels to Libia.
5. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto. Maximum weight and dimensions.
6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 25th day of March, 1913. Commencement of Warrant.
