THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 68)
WARRANT, 1914. DATED DECEMBER 31, 1914.

1914. No. 1868.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Act, 1908,^(a) and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows :—

1. This Warrant may be cited as “The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 68) Warrant, 1914.” Short title.
2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906^(b) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Warrant”), and all Warrants amending the same. Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.
3. On all outgoing parcels addressed to any place specified in the Schedule hereto there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage mentioned against the name of such place in the said Schedule. Amended rates on parcels.
4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto. Maximum Weight and dimensions.

5. Part II. of the Schedule to the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 30) Warrant, 1909,^(a) and the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 60) Warrant, 1914,^(b) are hereby repealed.

6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of February, 1915.
