## Republic of Colombia.

THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 80) WARRANT, 1916. DATED AUGUST 25, 1916.

> No. 574. 1916.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1915,(a) and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 80) Warrant, 1916."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,(b) and all Warrants amending the same.(c)

Rates on parcels to Colombia.

3. On all outgoing parcels addressed to the Republic of Colombia there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.

Maximum weight and dimensions.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Repeal.

5. The entries in Part I. of the Second Schedule to the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906, relating to parcels addressed to the Republic of Colombia are hereby repealed.

Commencement of Warrant.

6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1916.
