

Charge for Fulfilment of Customs Formalities.

THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT
(No. 86) WARRANT, 1918. DATED NOVEMBER 22, 1918.

1918. No. 1544.

We the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1918,^(a) and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 86) Warrant, 1918."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,^(b) and all Warrants amending the same.

Charge for fulfilment of Customs formalities.

3. In respect of every incoming parcel to which such Regulations as are referred to in Section 14 of the Post Office (Parcels) Act, 1882,^(c) apply, and upon the contents of which any duty is payable under the Customs Acts, there shall be charged and paid the further rate or fee of twopence.

Commencement of Warrant.

4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 2nd day of December, 1918.
