1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short title Parcel Post Amendment (No. 88) Warrant, 1919."

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,(a) and all Warrants amending the same.

- 3. On every outgoing parcel addressed to Mexico and transmitted under this Warrant, there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.
- 4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Repeal.

5. The entry in Part I. of the Second Schedule to the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906, relating to parcels addressed to Mexico, is hereby repealed.

Commencement of Warrant. Date.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1919.
