THE FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST AMENDMENT (No. 92)
WARRANT, 1919. DATED SEPTEMBER 6, 1919.

1919. No. 1237.

We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1918,^(a) and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 92) Warrant, 1919."

Short Title.

2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,^(b) and all Warrants amending the same.

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants.

3. Parcels may be transmitted by post from the Agency of the Postmaster-General established at Tangier to Egypt, subject to the rates of postage mentioned in the said Schedule.

Rates on parcels from Tangier to Egypt.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the dimensions of which shall exceed the dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Maximum dimensions.

5. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 15th day of September, 1919.
