We, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by the Post Office Acts, 1908 to 1918,(a) and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant made on the representation of His Majesty's Postmaster-General (testified by his signing the same) and under the hands of two of us, the said Commissioners, order, direct, and declare as follows:—

1. This Warrant may be cited as "The Foreign and Colonial Short Title. Parcel Post Amendment (No. 94) Warrant, 1919."

Warrant to be read with existing Warrants. Rates on certain parcels to Venezuela. Maximum weight and dimensions. 2. This Warrant shall be read as one with the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Warrant, 1906,(a) and all Warrants amending the same.

3. On every outgoing parcel addressed to Venezuela and transmitted under this Warrant there shall be charged and paid the rates of postage specified in the Schedule hereto.

4. Except by permission of the Postmaster-General, there shall not be forwarded, conveyed or delivered by post under this Warrant any parcel the weight or dimensions of which shall exceed the weight and dimensions specified in the Schedule hereto.

Repeal.

5. The Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 53) Warrant, 1912,(b) so far as that Warrant relates to parcels addressed to Venezuela, and the Foreign and Colonial Parcel Post Amendment (No. 6) Warrant, 1914,(c) are hereby repealed.

6. This Warrant shall come into operation on the 21st day of October, 1919.
